

Introduction:

Sri AdichunchanagiriShikshana Trust (R.) was established in 1975 Holiness Bhyravikya Jagadguru Padmabushana Sri Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji with the prime aim of enlightening the rural masses. The trust is an integral part of the age old Sri Adichunchanagiri Mutt, which is serving mankind in various possible ways and means, especially: Trivida Dasoha - Anna, Akshara, Arogya i.e. Food, Education, Health. Sri Adichunchanagiri Shikshana Trust (R.) is managed by the Managing Committee Presidentship of his Holiness Jagadguru Sri Dr.Nirmalanandanatha Mahaswamiji, who is giving the institution altogether a new dimension with a scientific outlook, cultural backward and a spiritual touch. Presently, the trust is running more than 500 education institutions, ranging from Pre-Primary to Post Graduation including: Engineering, Pharmacy, Nursing and Medical Sciences across the country and even in abroad.

Sri Adichunchanagiri First Grade College lies in Channarayapatna on the Bangalore-Mangalore National Highway 75 in Karnataka; it is one of the oldest, distinguished co-educational institutions at rural area in Hassan district, having Famous Jain pilgrimage Shravanbelogola. Channarayapatna has major railway connection from Bengaluru to Mangaluru, Karwar and Mysuru.

The Institution began in 1979 with less than 100 students. It is situated in the heart of the city with own campus. The college is affiliated to the Hassan University and recognized by UGC under Section 2(f) and 12(b) of UGC Act 1999.

In the 1st cycle of NAAC accreditation, the institution secured a 'B+' grade with a CGPA of 75.95. In the 2ndcycle, it secured a 'B' grade with a CGPA of 2.54. In the 3rd cycle, the institution secured a 'B+' grade with a CGPA of 2.64.

Currently, a total number of students are enrolled in the institution, pursuing their dreams of higher education, supported by 28 faculty members, including

permanent management faculty. The institution offers 8 UG programs across various streams: Arts (BA - HEP/HSG/HEG/HES/EKP), Science (B.Sc. PCM/CBZ), and Commerce (B.Com). To enrich the knowledge of our students, ICT facilities have been installed, helping them face global challenges. Academic programs are guided by a team of well-qualified faculty members, including those with Ph.D., M.Phil., NET/SET qualifications, and experienced UGC and non-UGC faculty.



Interpretation of Feedback from Faculty Members on Curriculum, Infrastructure, Governance and IQAC

The feedback collected from faculty members regarding the curriculum, infrastructure, governance, and IQAC has been overwhelmingly positive. About 27% of the faculty members rated the following areas—Curriculum, Infrastructure, Governance, and IQAC—as excellent, while 72% rated them as good.

Action Taken:

- 1. Curriculum: The IQAC has instructed the concerned faculty members to further enhance the curriculum and align it with the latest trends and developments in their respective fields to raise the quality to an excellent level.
- 2. **Infrastructure:** The feedback highlighted the strengths of the institution's infrastructure. However, to further improve, the IQAC has recommended conducting a thorough review of the current facilities and identifying areas for future upgrades to ensure that the infrastructure meets the highest standards of excellence.
- 3. Governance: While the governance was rated highly, the IQAC has emphasized the importance of ensuring transparency and efficiency in all administrative processes. The faculty has been encouraged to provide suggestions to refine governance further, ensuring it becomes exemplary.

4. IQAC: The IQAC itself has been recognized for its role in maintaining academic quality. To elevate this further, the IQAC has recommended additional workshops and training programs for faculty and staff to enhance its functioning and effectiveness.

Additionally, the IQAC has directed all faculty members to actively work on improving the areas mentioned in the feedback form, aiming to elevate the rating to excellent in the next feedback cycle.


Feedback from Alumni on Academic, College, Administration and Infrastructure

Interpretation of Feedback from Alumni on Academics College, Administration and Infrastructure

The feedback from 26 alumni on various aspects of the institution offers valuable insights into their experiences.

The alumni feedback for the academic year 2023-24 highlighted several areas of strength and opportunities for improvement. Most alumni rated the academic procedure, infrastructure, and faculty positively, but 3 alumni found the academic procedure and faculty performance "Unsatisfactory." The fee structure and library services received mixed responses, with some alumni suggesting a need for better affordability and resource enhancements. While the campus environment and academic progress were mostly well-rated, areas like teaching, placement, and the alumni association received notable dissatisfaction. Additionally, sports and cultural activities were seen as moderate, signalling the need for improvement in these areas.

Action Taken Report Based on Alumni Feedback (2023-24)

The alumni feedback has been instrumental in identifying areas for improvement, prompting several actions. To address concerns in academic procedure, a review has been initiated, and a committee is working to streamline the process. Faculty performance will be enhanced through professional development programs and workshops. The fee structure is under review, with plans to introduce more scholarships and assess affordability. Library services will be improved by upgrading resources and increasing digital access. A dedicated task force is focused on improving teaching and placement by collaborating with industry partners. Efforts to enhance the campus environment are on-going, including improvements to green spaces and cleanliness. The alumni association is being restructured to increase engagement, and plans for more sports and cultural activities are being implemented. These actions reflect the institution's commitment to addressing feedback and continuously improving the overall student experience.


"IQAC Analysis Report on Parent Feedback Regarding Academics, College, Administration, and Infrastructure for the Academic Year 2023-24"

Analysis Report: Parent Feedback on Academics, Administration, and Infrastructure (2023-24)

The feedback from 120 parents offers valuable insights into various aspects of the institution. Most parents (76 members) rated the course and satisfaction. expressing members with 44 curriculum positively, Communication with faculty was rated positively by 58 parents, while 59 were satisfied, though 3 were dissatisfied, suggesting some room for improvement. In comparison to nearby institutions, 57 parents rated the college as better, with 53 satisfied. Regarding faculty adequacy, 50 rated it as adequate, while 24 were dissatisfied, highlighting areas for improvement. On campus security, 65 parents rated it excellent, with 49 satisfied. The admission process was praised by 72 parents for its fairness and transparency, and 56 rated the administrative staff's cooperation positively. However, 8 parents found college information access difficult, indicating potential for improvement. Overall, the feedback highlights strengths in areas like admission, security, and communication, while some areas, such as faculty adequacy and information access, need attention.

Action Taken Report:



The actions being taken will focus on addressing these areas, aiming to foster an even more supportive and inclusive academic environment for all students.

Most respondents appreciate opportunities for professional development, but some seek more encouragement. Classroom, lab, and furniture facilities are viewed as adequate by many, but there are concerns about maintenance. Supporting infrastructure like toilets, drinking water, and parking is generally sufficient, though not universally accepted. Sports facilities and administrative efforts are seen as effective by some, but mixed feedback indicates areas for improvement. Lastly, the IQAC's efforts in promoting quality are generally positive, but there are issues in awareness and of effectiveness. Overall, the feedback highlights strengths in research, resources, and infrastructure, while also pointing to areas needing improvement, especially in communication and facility maintenance.

Action Taken:

The library's resources and accessibility are appreciated, but areas for improvement will be identified and acted upon. Professional development opportunities will continue, with further encouragement for participation in workshops and conferences. Maintenance of classrooms, labs, and furniture will be prioritized to address concerns raised. Efforts to improve supporting infrastructure, including toilets, drinking water, and parking, will be undertaken. While sports facilities and administrative efforts are generally viewed positively, further enhancement will be considered. Finally, the IQAC's initiatives will be strengthened, with a focus on raising awareness and improving effectiveness in promoting quality education.
