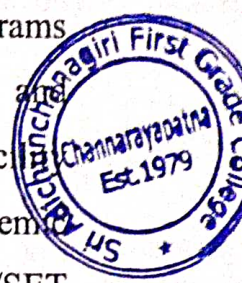

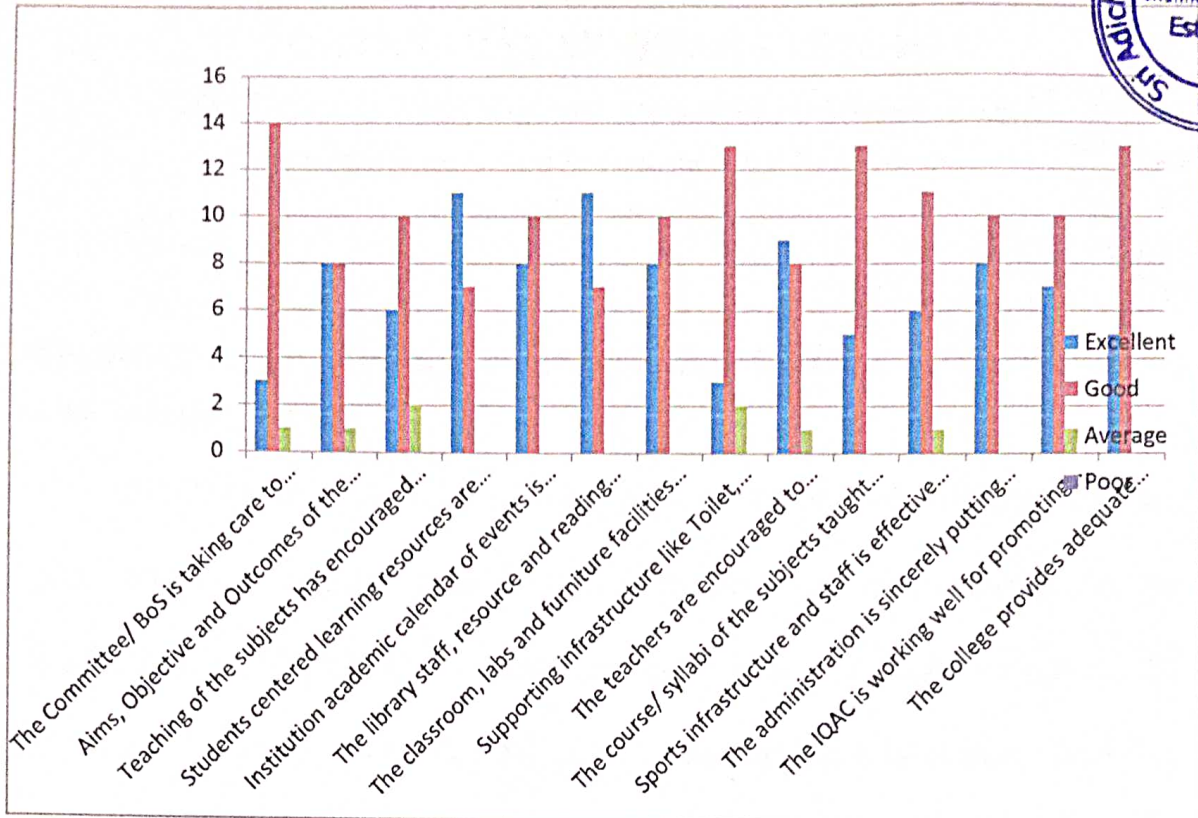
**Feedback from Faculty Members on Curriculum, Infrastructure,

and Infrastructure**

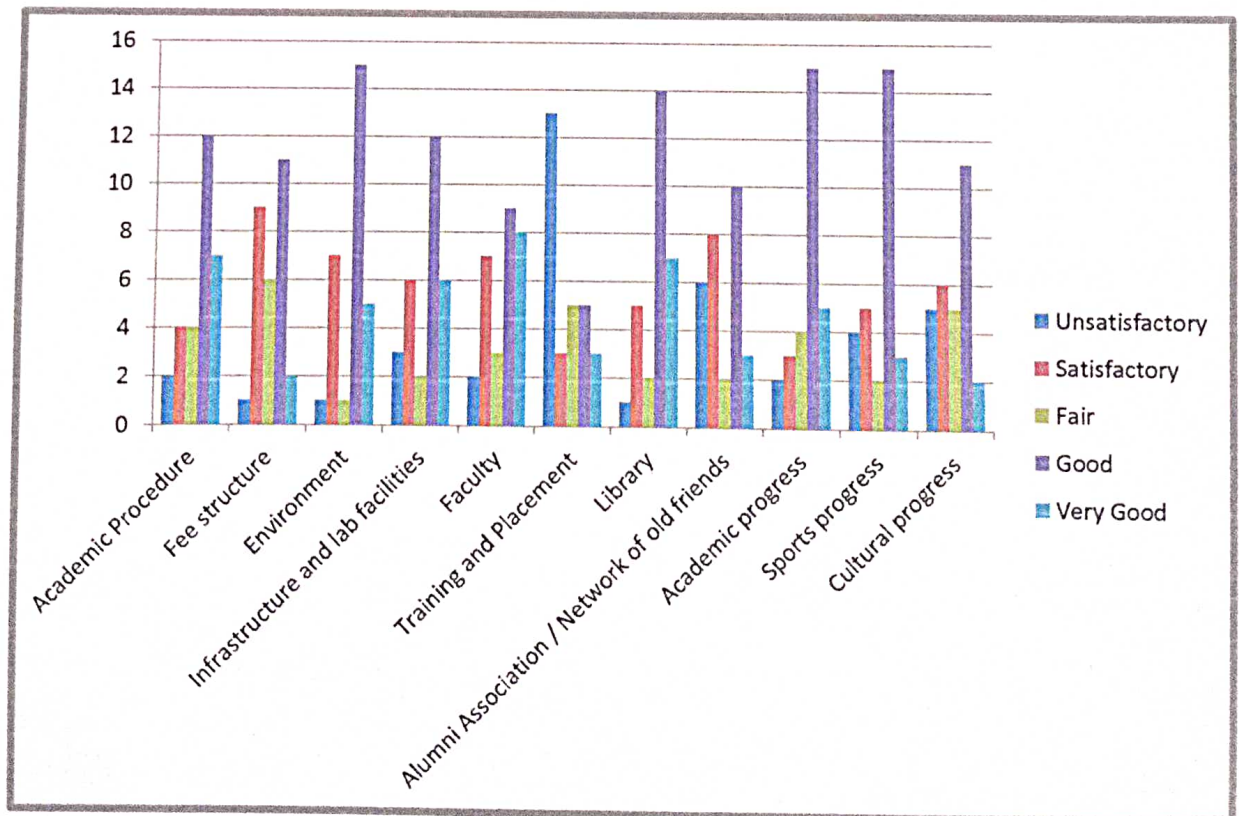

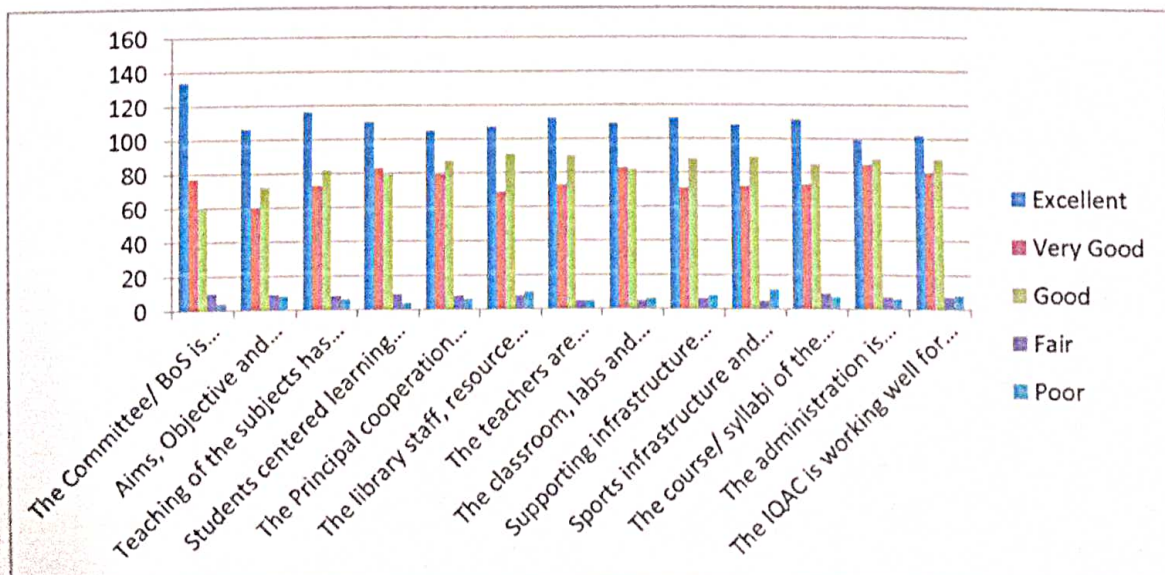
FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS ON CURRICULUM
