A Report on World Environment Day

On June 5, 2024, the Department of Botany celebrated World Environment Day in collaboration with the Youth Red Cross and Red Ribbon Unit. The purpose of the event was to raise awareness of environmental problems such as pollution, deforestation, climate change, and biodiversity loss. With a focus on land restoration, desertification, and drought resistance, this year's theme is "Our Land, Our Future, We Are Generation Restoration," underscoring the significance of these problems in attaining sustainable development.

On this occasion, a green festival was held and the seedling distribution programme was blessed by Sri Adichunchanagiri Mahasamsthan Math, Karnataka Stata children's sahitya parishad, Bhumi Samithi andolan, and BGS group educational institutions in association with Sri Adichunchanagiri College.

As everyone knows, the environment is extremely valuable to all living things. Without a wholesome atmosphere, we are nothing. To raise public awareness of the environment on Environment Day, a procession was held prior to the podium ceremony.
